The Honors Transfer Council of California's First Annual Conference Publicity Design Contest

What It Is:

Students submit original artwork and graphics to compete for the opportunity to have their design chosen to grace the poster, postcards, program cover, t-shirts, website, and name-tags of the Thirteenth Annual HTCC Student Research Conference (to be held in spring 2013). The winner will receive a \$150 prize and recognition in the 2013 conference program.

Who Is Eligible:

Students who attend an HTCC member college during at least one semester of the 2011-12 school year.

Specifications:

The original student artwork may be created in any medium, but the contest submission must adhere to the following guidelines:

- The artwork should be integrated with a motto/phrase that relates to the visual image and is indicative of a conference theme relevant to the HTCC's mission of promoting undergraduate research, creative thought, and academic excellence.
- The artwork and motto should be integrated with the relevant conference information in proportions similar to those of previous HTCC designs (see below).
- The integrated image should be made into an 11"-x-17" poster format and submitted as a PDF.

Once selected, the winner will be required to adjust and/or convert his/her design, including conference information, to fit the following additional formats: 4-x-6" (postcard, including text for reverse side); 8.5"-x-11" OR 17"-x-22" (program cover); 8.5"-x-11" or smaller (t-shirt); and a thumbnail for the webpage and nametags. Students may receive assistance from their college with the integration of graphics into the specified formats. See below for examples of formats.

Submission Instructions:

The artist or the Honors Program coordinator should submit a PDF of the contest entry to eoazolins@msjc.edu. Please indicate the student's name and college and use the subject heading "HTCC Art Contest." Please direct questions to Kay Ryals at kryals@ivc.edu.

Submission Deadline:

Monday, March 5, 2012

Other:

The winning design will become the property of the Honors Transfer Council of California. The organization will have the right to reproduce the design in any materials related to the HTCC. The student will receive a \$150 award but will receive no other compensation. Designs that do not win revert to the artist.


