Mr. Said Shokair, Director of the Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program at UCI, is offering four UCI research grants to students who present papers at the conference and subsequently undertake research as students at UCI. Matching grants are offered by complementary awards from Assistant Vice Chancellor Emeritus Juan Lara.

Selection is based on the quality of the student abstracts, with Mr. Shokair and Dr. Lara awarding up to a total of two grants for each of four major academic categories: humanities, mathematics, science, social sciences.

TO APPLY FOR THIS UCI RESEARCH GRANT:

1. Complete the appropriate Application and Registration form for the HTCC Student Research Conference (see the [Conference](#) page). Be sure to check the "UCI Student Research Grant" box on the form; this implies that *you plan on attending UCI the following fall* and wish to be considered for the award.
2. Prepare a 400-word abstract of your project or presentation. See the [Conference](#) page for instructions and hints on preparing an abstract.
3. Send the abstract by e-mail attachment in either MS Word (or RTF [Rich Text Format] if you do not use MS Word) to Prof. John Oakes (john.oakes@gcccd.edu), HTCC Scholarship Committee Chair.
4. Ensure that your abstract be *received* in readable condition by the second Wednesday in February. Abstracts received after that date, or in an unreadable format, may not be considered.
