

**Azusa Pacific University
Transfer Agreement with the
Honors Transfer Council of California**

Azusa Pacific University invites students in HTCC Honors Programs to consider transferring to the Azusa Pacific Honors Program for the junior and senior year. This will permit HTCC students to graduate with the B.A. degree as a distinguished Honors Scholar.

1. HTCC students will make application for admission to the University as a transfer student. Academic scholarships are granted in the general admission process, and not by the Honors program.
2. Every HTCC student who matriculates at APU is encouraged to study abroad. The value of an international experience is especially stressed to students in the Honors Program. APU has agreements to send 20 junior and 20 senior students to Oxford University each semester, to send eight to the International University in Vienna, to send a similar number to the European American International Center in Pontlevoy, France, and the list includes additional study opportunities in Australia, China, Lithuania, the Middle East, Russia, and others. APU permits the student's Federal and state aid to travel with them, and in many programs the student's APU academic scholarship may also apply.
3. The Christian ethos of the campus is very attractive to local and global scholars, and for this reason APU has become quite selective.
4. In conjunction with making application for admission to APU, HTCC students are asked to also apply for admission to the Honors Program, which requires the completion of the enclosed Honors Application. Transfers are expected to satisfy the following criteria for consideration –
 - Minimum SAT 1200 or ACT 27
 - Minimum college/university cumulative GPA 3.50
 - Students with cumulative GPA 3.75 or higher – no limit on admission
 - Students with a cumulative GPA 3.50 – 3.75 – limited to 5 admissions per year
 - Prerequisite college /university Honors credits
 - Transferring 25 – 48 units – Including a minimum of 9 Honors credits (grade B- or higher)
 - Transferring 49 – 59 units – Including a minimum of 12 Honors credits (grade B- or higher)
 - Transferring 60 or more units – Including a minimum of 15 Honors credits (grade B- or higher)

Advanced Placement & International Baccalaureate credits will not be considered for satisfaction of the Honors credit requirement. Nine Honors units of the 26 minimum units in Honors must be completed at Azusa Pacific University to qualify for Graduation as a distinguished Honors Scholar. Honors credits earned through study abroad will not count toward the required nine Honors units in residence. The application deadline for transfer students is May 1.
